Uptown District Attempted Carjacking

SUSPECT'S DESCRIPTION:

Perpetrator #1. Unknown B/M approximately 6' foot tall, wearing a white hoodie, with a black gator type mask over his face and dark pants.

Perpetrator #2 Unknown

Vehicle Silver in color, possibly a Nissan no further description

Reported Incident:

At approximately 11:25 PM, TUPD was notified of an Attempted Carjacking which occurred about one hour earlier in the 7600 block of Oak Street. According to the two victims, they arrived home and exited their vehicle. As they approached their residence, a silver vehicle stopped near them. A black male subject exited the vehicle and approached them. The subject displayed a handgun, while demanding the keys to their vehicle. One victim attempted to retrieve the keys from a backpack but was unable to locate them. At that point the victim dropped the bag on the ground, and both victims ran away. The perpetrator attempted to locate the keys but was unable to do so. He then fled north on Adams St. and the suspect vehicle fled west on Oak St
