## Off Campus: Car-Jacking Downtown District

### DATE & TIME of OCCURRENCE:

Wednesday 3/27/18 9:24 pm, 100 Block S. Saratoga St.

On Wednesday 3/27/18 TUPD officers responded to a Car-Jacking incident having occurred in the 100 block of S. Saratoga St. Four victims exited a vehicle, while leaving the engine running, and proceeded to unload groceries. As they attempted to gather the last few bags, a black male wearing a black hoodie appeared and jumped inside the vehicle. The suspect then drove off eastbound toward Canal St., then unknown.

The stolen vehicle is described as a 2012 Nissan Sentra, Silver in color, bearing La. License Plate 356AFP.

TUPD and NOPD officers are investigating and conducting follow-up steps regarding this incidents.

### SUSPECTS' DESCRIPTIONS:

The suspect is described as a black male, wearing a black hoodie sweatshirt, with no further description.
