Off-Campus Armed Robbery and Car-Jacking

On Wednesday 4/5/17 at approximately 10:14 p.m. a non-affiliated student was parked in the 2000 block of Adams street when two unknown black males armed with handguns approached and demanded the victim turn over the keys to their vehicle. The subjects attempted to flee but were unable to successfully operate the vehicle. The subjects took the victim's cell phone and fled the area.

A short time later a second non-affiliated subject reported that they had been the victim of a car-jacking in the 7000 block of Panola St. The victim reported that they were stopped in the driveway of the residence of a friend when two unknown black males armed with handguns approached and ordered the victim and a passenger out of the vehicle. The subjects subsequently entered the vehicle and fled the area in the direction of Broadway. The subjects involved in both incidents were described identically by the respective victims. TUPD along with NOPD officers responded to the incidents and conducted an extensive search of the surrounding area but were not able to locate the subjects or the stolen vehicle.

The subjects were described as 2 black males in their late teens to early twenties, medium build, approximately 5'9" – 5'10", wearing black hoodies over black pants.

The stolen vehicle is a Black 2006 Nissan Sentra bearing Louisiana license plate PYD 357

No further information at this time. NOPD along with TUPD are investigating.
