Off Campus Residential Burglary Uptown

At approximately 4:20pm, a student returned to his residence in the 900 block of Lowerline St. and noticed that his door was secured in a method that he normally did not utilize to secure it (dead-bolted). Upon making entry into the residence he discovered that his home had been ransacked and that the bedroom window screen had been kicked out.

While TUPD conducted the canvass of the area, it was discovered that a witness observed two subjects exiting the rear of the home. The subjects fled on foot eastbound on Burthe Street towards Broadway Street then unknown. No further information available at this time.

The victim described the suspects as follows:

#1 Black male, 18-21 years old, with a slim build wearing red sweatshirt and shoulder length dreadlocks.

#2 Black male, 18-21 years old, with a slim build wearing blue sweatshirt.

Descriptions provided by victim/witness.

Information about the race or ethnicity of alleged offenders is provided only to aid detailed descriptions that include physical stature, clothing or unusual characteristics. Racial descriptions do not, by themselves, offer a meaningful picture of an individual's appearance.
