Off-Campus Armed Robbery - Downtown

On August 1, at 9:20 AM, a male victim, non-affiliate, flagged down TUPD Officers pointed towards an unknown black male and female in 1200 block of Tulane Avenue and reported that they had just robbed him using a firearm. As TUPD Officers attempted to apprehend the subjects, they both fled on Tulane Avenue and eastbound onto Elk Place where the female subject was apprehended and found in possession of a firearm. The male subject continued on Elk Place, then riverbound onto Canal Street avoiding apprehension. The victim's property was recovered by the TUPD Officers.

Suspect was described as a Black Male, possibly a juvenile, twisted hairstyle, Burgundy hoodie, khaki pants, and a white backpack.

Descriptions provided by victim/witness.

Information about the race or ethnicity of alleged offenders is provided only to aid detailed descriptions that include physical stature, clothing or unusual characteristics. Racial descriptions do not, by themselves, offer a meaningful picture of an individual's appearance.
