Content Warning: This notification includes information related to an aggravated assault by shooting in our area.

Today, April 7, 2023, at approximately 2:20 pm, the Tulane University Police Department learned that an aggravated assault by shooting had occurred on Loyola Avenue in front of the New Orleans Public Library. New Orleans Police Department investigators shared that two non-Tulane affiliated individuals inside the library became involved in an altercation the became physical in nature. During the encounter the two began to fight over a firearm which resulted in the victim being shot twice in the chest. The perpetrator fled down Gravier in the direction of LaSalle and then unknown. No information related to the description of the perpetrator has been provided at this time.
