CRIME ALERT

Tulane University Police Department is providing this notice of a criminal incident (s) that occurred in our community in order to provide information that may help in avoiding a similar crime or provide information to solve this crime. This notice is also intended to meet the requirements of the "Timely Report" provisions of the federal Jeanne Clery Disclosure of Campus Security Policy and Campus Crime Statistics Act of 1998, amended 2008, effective August 14, 2008.

OFF CAMPUS ARMED ROBBERY

DATE & TIME OF OCCURRENCE:

Tuesday, September 17, 2013; 11:34 p.m.

LOCATION:

7400 block of Freret Street

REPORTED OFFENSE:

A student was walking westbound on Freret Street approaching Lowerline when he observed a white Camaro or Trans Am idling near the intersection. As the student crossed over Lowerline, the vehicle turned onto Freret behind him. One subject exited the passenger seat of the vehicle, approached the student from the rear, produced a black semiautomatic handgun and demanded that the student turn over personal property. The subject then returned to the vehicle and fled westbound on Freret Street and then unknown.

SUSPECT'S DESCRIPTION:

Subject 1: Black male, approximately 20-22 years of age, 5'11", thin build, dark complexion, short fade haircut, grey hoodie, possible tattoo on right cheek

Subject 2: Black male, approximately 30-35 years of age, red baseball cap (driver)

Subject 3: Black male (remained in rear of vehicle)

SUSPECT'S VEHICLE:

The subjects fled in a white 1980s or 1990s Chevrolet Camaro or Pontiac Trans Am with two black rally-style stripes running from the hood to the rear of the vehicle.

TUPD is working with NOPD to increase patrols in the area.
