Date and Time of Occurrence:

Wednesday 10/28/20, 9:43 pm.

LOCATION:

Off Campus – 900 block of Pine Street

Reported Incident:

Aggravated Assault with a firearm

SUSPECT'S DESCRIPTION:

Male, wearing dark clothing and a hoodie. No further description provided.

Victim reported that he and a friend returned to their residence and observed an unknown male dressed in all black kneeling in front of a commercial dumpster located across the street. The victim ran towards the suspect causing him to flee. The victim chased the suspect at which time the suspect yelled stop chasing me and fired a single shot in the direction of the victim. The victim stopped chasing the suspect who continued south on Pine.

TUPD along with NOPD responded to the scene but were unable to locate the suspect.
