CRIME ALERT

Tulane University Police Department is providing this notice of a criminal incident(s) that occurred in our community in order to provide information that may help in avoiding a similar crime or provide information to solve this crime. This notice is also intended to meet the requirements of the "Timely Report" provisions of the federal Jeanne Clery Disclosure of Campus Security Policy and Campus Crime Statistics Act of 1998, amended 2008, effective August 14, 2008.

Off Campus Armed Robbery

DATE & TIME OF OCCURRENCE: June 22, 2012 at 2202 hours

LOCATION: 1037 Broadway The Mushroom

REPORTED OFFENSE: NOPD handled a report of an armed robbery in which two suspects entered the Mushroom and robbed the cashier and the store manager. The suspects cased the store and waited for the customers to leave. Suspect asked to use the bathroom and was told "No." He came behind the counter and produced a small revolver and demanded money from the register. He went to the back office and demanded money from the office safe (approximately \$200.00 from the office safe and \$3700.00 cash from the register. Suspects fled southbound on foot down Broadway then unknown.

SUSPECTS' DESCRIPTIONS: Suspect #1 is described as a black male 6'1" - 6'2" 220-240lbs, 30-40 years of age, dark complexion wearing a black halter top dress over a white tank top; two tone ball cap with dark brim over a straight black wig, shoulder length bob style.

Suspect #2. Hispanic or Black male, 5'8"-5'10", 30-40 years of age, medium complexion short hair light color t-shirt, baggy pants, white bandana over lower portion of face.

SUSPECTS' VEHICLES: Unknown

TUPD is working with NOPD to increase patrols in the area
