Off-Campus Residential Burglaries

DATE & TIME OF OCCURRENCE:

- (1) 12/24/16 7:30am – 4:00pm 12/30/16
- (2) 12/18/16 – 9:30pm 12/31/16

LOCATION:

- (1) 7800 Block St. Charles
- (2) 2100 Block Lowerline

REPORTED OFFENSES:

- (1) A student reported that on Friday 12/30/16 she arrived to home to her residence after having been gone since 12/24/16 and discovered the front door lock to her apartment had been defeated. She conducted an inventory of her residence and determined that nothing had been taken at that time.
- (2) A faculty member reported that on Saturday 12/31/16 he returned to his residence after having been gone since 12/18/16 and discovered the rear window of his residence had been broken. It appeared as if someone had gone through the structure although nothing was discovered missing at that time.

In addition to these incidents the New Orleans Police Department is reporting residential burglaries at the following locations all having occurred sometime over the holiday season:

- (1) 12/30/16 Jefferson and Lasalle
- (2) 12/30/16 7800 block of St. Charles

SUSPECTS' DESCRIPTIONS:
