## Off-Campus Simple Robbery Uptown

On Friday 10/20/17 at 11:18 pm (3) female Tulane students were walking westbound on Willow Street and were approached by an unknown male white subject at the corner of Willow Street and Audubon Blvd. The subject then asked the female students if he could use a mobile phone. When he was refused, the subject took a mobile phone from (1) of the female students and fled northbound on Audubon Blvd., entered an unknown vehicle, and continued north bound on Audubon Blvd. to Claiborne Avenue then unknown.

The subject was described as an unknown male white, curly hair (short), wearing a red jersey and dark blue jeans. He was also described as "tweaky".
